

Team Belize Prayer Calendar April 2020

- Wed 1 Pray for the Government of Belize. Pray that the leaders would make wise decisions in governing the people during the COVID-19 crisis. (A state of emergency will begin tonight at mid-night after a third case has been diagnosed.) Pray for salvation of the political leaders.
- Thurs 2 Praise for a good trip for Anita Chambers as she assisted at the clinic for two weeks with clinic administration, giving "in-service" for the clinic staff, and assisting the Call family in their assimilation to life and ministry in Belize. Garry cancelled his trip due to the coronavirus outbreak.
 Pray for Garry and Anita as they give leadership to all of MTW's Caribbean ministries. Ask God to grant physical and spiritual strength and wisdom in guiding these ministries.
- Fri 3 Pray for the Belize churches to have wisdom in holding services via electronic means as not all church members have internet/data access. Ask God to protect the pastors and elders as they minister to their congregations. Pray for health and safety for the clinic staff as they minister and care for those who may have the coronavirus.
- Sat 4 Ask God to bring a revival in Belize. Pray that God will protect the Presbyterian pastors, elders, deacons, school teachers, clinic staff, mercy ministry workers, and MTW missionaries from the attacks of the world, their flesh, and the devil. Ask God to grant them health, strength, and spiritual growth. Also Ask God to supply all their physical needs at this time.
- Sun 5 Praise for the Presbyterian Medical Clinic receiving first and second place ratings in all categories of the Key Performance Indicators among the 11 NHI clinics in Belize. Pray for the staff to remain faithful in witnessing to patients and extending compassionate care. They have 11 staff members: Pamela Murray, Dr. Einstein Bodden, Patty Ku, Esther Ku, Mariana Lopez, Arturo Ku, Marcos Balaam, Hilario Nah, Marcela Villamil, Rosa Uh, and nurse midwife, Estela Uk.
- Mon 6 Pray for John and Karen Stodghill (MTW) as they minister in Belize. Ask God to give them wisdom, strength, and guidance in ministry through the power of the Spirit especially as they seek creative ways in ministry with group meetings being canceled. Pray for health and safety during the coronavirus outbreak. Ask God to raise up additional missionaries to serve on the Belize team.
- Tues 7 Continue to pray for Ray and Michelle Call and their family as they adjust to life and ministry in Belize. Ask to protect them during the virus outbreak and to supply all their needs. Pray for wisdom as they seek creative ways to minister to the Orange Walk and San Pablo churches without having group meetings.
- Wed 8 Pray that pastors, elders, deacons, and school teachers, will seek first God's Kingdom, trust in God's sovereign rule and know His peace and joy daily as they serve in their various ministry Roles. Ask God to grant good working relationships and a spirit of unity among the leaders.
 Pray for the seminary board of directors as they lead the seminary.

- Thurs 9 Pray for the Patchakan Presbyterian (Holy Trinity) Church for spiritual growth for its members and the leaders as well as the members of the Chan Chen and Caledonia mission churches. Ask for protection from the attacks of the enemy and the world. Pray for Pastor Ishmael (wife, Leti) and his family to be protected from the enemy and for wisdom in ministry. Pray for spiritual and numerical growth of the church and mission churches.
- Fri 10 Pray for the pastors of the Presbyterian Church in Belize as the church giving has decrease with the loss of jobs in the past two weeks. Pray that God will supply for the pastors and for others who have lost their income. The traditional Good Friday service is cancelled today.
- Sat 11 Pray for Leogardo Catzim (wife, Jenny) and his family. Pray for numerical and spiritual growth in the San Jose, San Pablo, and Orange Walk churches where Leogardo pastors. Pray that he will be a good husband and father. Ask God to protect their family from the schemes of Satan. Pray for wisdom and time management as he works with the churches, serves as the treasurer of executive committee, and also serves on commissions of presbytery.
- **Sun 12 He is risen! Rejoice** and give **thanks** for Christ's victory over sin and death and the salvation it brings to the world! **Pray** that the Easter message will bring new life to many this year!
- Mon 13 Pray for God to give the Presbyterian school teachers and staff wisdom to know how to minister to their students and their families during this time of school closure.

- Wed 15 Pray for Ernest Betson and wife, Carolyn, as they continue medical care for Carolyn's chronic health issues. Pray for the ministry of the St. Andrews and Unity churches, the homeless ministry, and Unity School. Praise that God is raising up male leadership (Adrian, Mark, Owen, and Dennis) for the churches in Belize City.
- Thurs 16 Pray for Harvest Presbyterian Church (Calcutta Village mission church, near Corozal town) meeting Sunday afternoons. Pray for Ishmael Lopez, church member who is taking a leadership role for the church. Praise for new people who are attending the church! Ask God to bring people to faith through the ministry of the church and to lead others who are seeking a church home to the congregation. Pray for spiritual growth and maturity for those attending.
- Fri 17 Pray for Bethany Presbyterian Mission Church in Cayo as John and Karen Stodghill (MTW) continue their ministry role at the church. Pray that the church will not lose momentum during the virus closure but that more people will seek out the church for comfort and come to faith.
- Sat 18 Pray for Pastor Eliseo de La Cruz, his wife, Amada and family as they continue to minister at the Bethel Presbyterian Church in Cristo Rey village and the mission churches in Louisville and Xaibe.
 Pray for spiritual and numerical growth of the three churches. Ask God to fill Pastor Eliseo with His Spirit and protect his family from the attacks of the enemy.
- Sun 19 Ask God to protect the church families from the attacks from the world, their own flesh, and Satan's attacks on the family. Pray that parents would have wisdom in raising their children to know Christ and to love and serve Him.

- Tues 21 Pray for St. Andrews Presbyterian Church that God will grow the church spiritually and numerically. Pray for the homeless ministry in Belize City: ask God to guide Adrian and Monique Bartley as they lead the ministry and that many will come to faith through the ministry.
 Pray for an increased impact into the community as people see the church's ministry.
- Wed 22 Pray for Pastor Juan Patt (wife, Maria and family) as he ministers at Prince of Peace Presbyterian Church in Corozal and at Harvest Presbyterian Church in the Village of Calcutta. Ask God to continue to build the Prince of Peace and Harvest Presbyterian Churches. Pray for physical and spiritual health for Juan and Maria as they minister. Ask God to raise up elders for the church.
- Thurs 23 Pray for pastors: Ernest Betson, Juan Patt, Leogardo Catzim, Alvaro Pott, Eliseo de la Cruz, Ismael Puente and ruling elders: Hilario Nah and Isaias Botes, along with missionaries John Stodghill and Ray Call as they prepare sermons & devotions to share electronically. Ask God to empower the preaching and teaching of His Word and for lives to be transformed.

- Tues 28 Praise for increased attendance at Bethany Presbyterian Church in Cayo! Pray that God will continue to grow the church by bringing former members back and through evangelism and discipleship. Pray for John and Karen Stodghill as they work with Presbytery to guide this ministry.
- Wed 29 Pray for the San Pablo and Louisville congregations who are wanting to finish training elders and install them so they can become particular churches. Give praise for spiritual and numerical growth of several churches in Belize. Also pray for a spiritual awakening in Belize.
