

## Team Belize Prayer Calendar September 2020

- Tues 1 Pray for the Belize government to have wisdom as they face an increase in crime. Also, as COVID cases spiked in Belize by 900 cases, fatalities are increasing. The main hospital in Belize City is full. Belize is on tight lockdown again so churches cannot meet. Pray that the government will make wise decisions and will treat the Church as a critical component of society. Pray for wisdom as the Stodghills, Calls, and all the Belize pastors seek to continue their various church activities online for the indefinite future. Pray for the continued financial pressures placed on families as the economy struggles due to the pandemic.
- Wed 2 Pray for Harvest Presbyterian Church (Calcutta Village mission church, near Corozal town) as they adjust to not being able to meet together again. Ask God to bring people to faith through the ministry of the church. Pray for spiritual growth and maturity for the attendees, that they would be filled with knowledge and spiritual wisdom and would walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to Him being fruitful.
- Thurs 3 Pray for Leogardo Catzim (wife, Jenny) and his family. Pray for numerical and spiritual growth in the San Jose church. Praise that Ray Call is now assisting Leogardo at the San Pablo and Orange Walk churches where Leogardo pastors. Pray that Leogardo will be a good husband and father. Ask God to protect their family from the schemes of Satan. Pray for wisdom and time management as he works with the churches, serves as the treasurer of executive committee and also serves on commissions of presbytery.
- Fri 4 Schools will open in early September all online throughout the country. Pray for Presbyterian Day School who had their limited government stipend cut by 1/3 this year. MTW and the Belize team have set up an MTW account to assist the school with capital projects and shortfalls in teacher salaries. We are soliciting for donations and sponsors in this effort.
- Sat 5 Pray for the staff of the Presbyterian Medical Clinic as they serve the community while taking precautions for COVID-19. Pray for the staff to remain faithful in witnessing to patients and extending compassionate care. Also, pray that some needed medicine and medical supplies and equipment can be sent to the clinic. They have 11 staff members: Pamela Murray, Dr. Einstein Bodden, Patty Ku, Esther Ku, Mariana Lopez, Arturo Ku, Marcos Balaam, Hilario Nah, Marcela Villamil, Rosa Uh, and nurse midwife, Estela Uk.
- Sun 6 Pray for John and Karen Stodghill (MTW) as they minister in Santa Elena. Ask God to give them wisdom, protection, and guidance as the church begins meeting together at the church building again. Praise that two missionary candidate families are interested in joining the Belize Team. Pray that both families will be able to make site visits as soon as possible for the next step in their application process. John also asks prayer for a Bible study to begin in the capital, Belmopan, this fall as the first step for planning a new ministry site.

## **Belize Team Vision Statement:**

- Mon 7 Continue to pray for Ray and Michelle Call and their family. Ray is teaching leadership development class on Tuesday nights via Zoom for men from the San Pablo and Orange Walk churches. He leads prayer meeting for both churches on Wednesday, holds Zoom service on Sunday and records sermons on YouTube for those who do not have reliable internet. Michele leads a women's Zoom Bible study for the Orange Walk Church and hopes to start a mothers' prayer meeting at Presbyterian Day School.
- Tues 8 John Stodghill asks prayer for church officers training for two men at Bethany Church. Pray that pastors, elders, deacons, and school teachers will seek first God's Kingdom, trust in God's sovereign rule and know His peace and joy daily as they serve in their various ministry roles.
  Ask God to grant good working relationships and a spirit of unity among the leaders. Pray for the seminary board of directors as they lead the seminary.
- Wed 9 Pray that God would protect church members and communities in Belize from a serious case of COVID-19, especially the elderly and those with other conditions. Pray that many people will come to faith in Belize during this time when people are fearful of sickness and death. John and Ray both ask us to pray that God would give the Church a desire to evangelize and that hearts will be ready to receive the Gospel message during these uncertain times.
- Thurs 10 Pray for Garry and Anita Chambers who hope to travel to Belize in mid-October to assist at the clinic during the administrator's maternity leave and for Garry to serve with the MTW team and the national church leaders in various aspects of ministry. Pray for Pam Murray (clinic administrator) as she prepares for her maternity leave which is to begin early October.
- Fri 11 John Stodghill asks prayer for the clinic to be able to raise funds to replace the clinic vehicle as the current vehicle is in poor condition after 16 years of hard use. It is used daily for clinic business and to transport clinic medical volunteers to and from the airport. MTW has set up an account to receive funds (need is \$50K) to assist with this need.
- Sat 12 Pray for the Patchakan Presbyterian (Holy Trinity) Church for spiritual growth for its members and the leaders as well as the members of the Chan Chen and Caledonia mission churches. Ask for protection from the attacks of the enemy and the world. Pray for Pastor Ishmael (wife, Leti) and his family to be protected from the enemy and for wisdom in ministry. Pray for spiritual and numerical growth of the church and mission churches. Ask God to give wisdom in ministering to the church during this difficult time of lockdown.
- Sun 13 Pray for God to give the Presbyterian school teachers and staff wisdom to know how to minister to their students and families. Pray for the children as they are doing online school since there are many families who do not have internet or computers at their homes. Ray and Michele ask prayer for their children who will be starting at new schools and will be making friends.
- Mon 14 Pray for God to raise up mature Christian men to serve as pastors, elders, and deacons. Also, pray for provisions to train them. Pray for ruling elders: Solomon Noh, Ishmael Vallejos, Wilbert Vallejos, Hilario Nah, Isais Botes, Desi Chan, Inocente Patt, and Roman Chan. Ask God to give them wisdom in leading the churches in Belize. Pray that they will lead by example of living godly lives, encouraging and building up those they lead and forgiving others as they have been forgiven.
- Tues 15 Pray for Ernest Betson and wife, Carolyn, and her ongoing health needs. Pray for the ministry of the Saint Andrews and Unity churches, the homeless ministry, and Unity School. Praise that God is raising up male leadership (Adrian, Mark, Owen, and Dennis) for the churches in Belize City.
  Pray for the homeless ministry as many more people are coming for food since the lockdown.

## **Belize Team Vision Statement:**

- Wed 16 Ask God to bring a revival in Belize. Pray that God's Spirit will pour out His power on His people in Belize granting repentance from sin, having a love for Christ, new obedience and zeal for evangelism. Ask God to protect the Presbyterian pastors, elders, deacons, school teachers, clinic staff, mercy ministry workers, and MTW missionaries from the attacks of the world, their flesh, and the devil.
- Thurs 17 Pray for Bethany Presbyterian Mission Church in Cayo as John and Karen Stodghill (MTW) continue their ministry role at the church. Praise for Yamilette who recently came to faith and is now a part of the church. Pray for the youth ministry and for the Sunday School classes which have started again. Also John asks prayer for the leadership training at Bethany, Unity, and St. Andrews Presbyterian churches
- Fri 18 Pray for Pastor Eliseo de La Cruz, his wife, Amada and family as they continue to minister at the Bethel Presbyterian Church in Cristo Rey village and the mission churches in Louisville and Xaibe.
  Pray for spiritual and numerical growth of the three churches. Ask God to fill Pastor Eliseo with His Spirit and protect his family from the attacks of the enemy.
- Sat 19 Pray for the Presbytery Meeting being held today. Ask God to guide the discussions and decisions that will be made. Pray for unity even during the isolation of COVID. Also, pray for Adrian Bartley and presbytery to be able to arrange training for Adrian to become an ordained pastor for Belize Presbytery. Pray for the pastors of the Presbyterian Church in Belize as the church giving has decrease with the loss of jobs. Pray that God will supply for those who have lost their income.
- Sun 20 Pray for opportunities and boldness in all churches to share the gospel during this time and for a harvest of many souls for the glory of Christ. Pray that Satan would not be effective in his attacks against the Church in Belize in 2020. Pray that God would protect Christian families and that they would be a strong witness for Christ. Ask God to give spiritual victory to grow and mature the church in Belize beyond our expectations.
- Mon 21 Pray for St. Andrews Presbyterian Church that God will grow the church spiritually and numerically. Pray for the homeless ministry in Belize City: ask God to guide Adrian and Monique Bartley as they lead the ministry and that many will come to faith through the ministry.
  Pray for an increased impact into the community as people observe the church's ministry. Pray for safety as they serve the community during the COVID-19 outbreak.
- Tues 22 Pray for Pastor Juan Patt (wife, Maria and family) as he ministers at Prince of Peace Presbyterian Church in Corozal and at Harvest Presbyterian Church in the village of Calcutta. Ask God to continue to build the Prince of Peace and Harvest Presbyterian Churches. Pray for physical and spiritual health for Juan and Maria as they minister. Ask God to raise up elders for the church.
- Wed 23 Pray for pastors: Ernest Betson, Juan Patt, Leogardo Catzim, Alvaro Pott, Eliseo de la Cruz, Ismael Puente and ruling elders: Hilario Nah and Isaias Botes, along with missionaries, John Stodghill and Ray Call, as they prepare sermons & devotions to share electronically. Ask God to empower the preaching and teaching of His Word and for lives to be transformed.
- Thurs 24 Ask God to give wisdom to the church sessions, commissions and committees of presbytery as they lead the Church. Ask God to bring a ministry of reconciliation throughout the churches of the PCB (Presbyterian Church in Belize). Pray for the executive committee of presbytery as they guide the work of presbytery and as they assist church sessions to grow and mature in their leadership of local churches.

## **Belize Team Vision Statement:**

- Fri 25 Ask God to call more men to the pastorate and church leadership for the Presbyterian churches. There are only six active pastors and eight elders for the 16 Presbyterian congregations. Pray that seminary training can be made available to Adrian Bartley as he senses God's call to the pastorate.
   Pray for the churches to be effective in reaching the youth of Belize. Pray that God would call several youth into full-time Christian service in 2020.
- Sat 26 Pray for restoration of interpersonal relationships throughout the churches. Ask God to enable church members to follow Christ's example by humbling themselves to be servants to others.
  Pray for pastors & church leaders to flee and overcome temptation and discouragement. Pray for their spiritual renewal. Pray that pastors, elders, deacons, SS teachers, clinic staff, and Presbyterian school teachers will be men and women of prayer and faithful witnesses for Christ.
- Sun 27 Pray for a spiritual revival in the churches in Belize and for a spiritual awakening that will see many come to faith across Belize. Pray for the gospel to transform lives and bring peace in the hearts of the people and healing in marriages and families. Ask God to open doors to evangelize the lost and that He would grant Christians boldness to share during this time of fear and concern.
- Mon 28 Pray for Bethany Presbyterian Church in Cayo! Pray that God will protect the church families from the attacks from Satan, the world, their own flesh. Pray that parents would have wisdom in raising their children to know Christ and to love and serve Him. John Stodghill asks prayer that families would see the importance of the institution of marriage and that God would protect the marriages of the church leaders. Pray that God will continue to grow the church by bringing former members back, through evangelism, and discipleship. Pray for John and Karen Stodghill as they work with Presbytery to guide this ministry.
- Tues 29 Pray for the San Pablo and Louisville congregations who are wanting to finish training elders and install them so they can become particular churches. Continue to pray for the officer training on Tuesday nights. Give praise for spiritual and numerical growth of several churches in Belize.
  Also pray for a spiritual awakening in Belize.
- Wed 30 Pray for the seminary Board of Directors President -TE Juan Patt, Secretary-Lidia Tzul, Treasurer-TE Eliseo de la Cruz, Counsellor-RE Abert Zantingh, Support-RE Alfonso Vallejos, Ex Oficio-Ray Call/Garry Chambers. Ask God to call men to serve as pastors, elders, and deacons for the churches. Pray that God will call more missionaries to serve in Belize to assist with the ministry.
