

- SAT 1** – **Pray** for the MTW leadership over Belize. John Stodghill, Team Leader; Garry Chambers, Regional Director (for the Caribbean); Steve Robertson, International Director (for the Americas); Cartee Bales, Senior Director of Field Operations (international); Lloyd Kim, Coordinator of MTW and the committee to Mission to the World (worldwide). **Pray** that God would give them wisdom in directing the missionaries and ministries under them in such a way as glorifies the Lord.
- SUN 2** - **Pray** for the Board of Directors of Reformed Leadership Institute of Belize: President -TE Juan Patt, Counsellor-RE Albert Zantingh, ex officio-Ray Call/Garry Chambers. **Pray** God will call more men to the pastorate and church leadership for the Presbyterian churches. There are only four active Belizean pastors and one missionary pastor and eleven elders serving the 16 Presbyterian congregations.
- MON 3** – **Pray** for 8 presbyterian schools throughout the country as they continue with in person learning. **Pray** the teachers find their wisdom and strength from the Lord as the Bible says all scripture is inspired by God and profitable for teaching, reproof, correction, and for training in righteousness. **Pray** the teachers will proclaim God boldly, admonishing, and teaching each student with wisdom, so as to present each child as equipped for every good work.
- TUES 4** - **Pray** for Leogardo Catzim (wife, Jenny) and his family. **Pray** for numerical and spiritual growth in the San Jose, and San Pablo church. **Pray** that the Orange Walk church would see increasing attendance and pray for renewed commitment among congregants. **Pray** for energy and good health as Leogardo works with the churches, serves on the executive committee, and serves on commissions of presbytery. Continue to **pray** for Ray (wife, Michele, and family) as Ray helps pastor Leogardo with 2 churches in the Orange Walk district.
- WED 5** –**Pray** for Cornerstone High School to find a permanent principal, and for the urgent need to find teachers for each of the positions that are currently vacant. **Pray** for several teachers at the Cornerstone High School that have serious health problems. **Pray** the school would be known for their academic excellence. **Pray** school will be a place for many children to come to faith.
- THUR 6** –**Pray** for Bethany Presbyterian church in the Cayo district where John and Karen Stodghill are serving as MTW missionaries under the direction of Pastor Ernest Betson and his elders from St. Andrews Presbyterian Church in Belize City. **Pray** for John Stodghill as he preaches and leads devotions and teaches the youth Sunday School class. **Pray** for Elder John Sierra as he aids in leading the congregation through language translation and other church decisions. **Praise God** the church is growing in numbers; **pray** they are growing in their faith and relationship with God. **Pray** for Karen Stodghill as she leads the Sunday School for the preschool and primary age students of Bethany Presbyterian church and leads the women’s ministry. **Pray** for a deeper understanding of scripture that will lead to a life of trusting God and serving others with a loving heart.
- FRI 7**–**Pray** for Emmanuel Church in San Pablo to move towards particularization. **Pray** for the elder training classes that began the end of September and **pray** the classes would result in a new elder candidate. **Pray** for active church attendance among members.
- SAT 8**–**Pray** for Faith Presbyterian church in Orange Walk, that they will find a full-time pastor that could be devoted to growing this church in this large town. Pray that old wounds would heal, and this would again become a vibrant, growing church.
- SUN 9** – **Pray** for the Bethel Presbyterian Church in Cristo Rey village and the mission church, Shalom, in Louisville and, Monte Sinai, in Xaibe, the Patchakan church and the Chan Chen church all up

in the Corozal district as the ruling elders are filling in the gaps as these churches do not currently have a pastor. **Pray** they are protected from the attacks of the evil one. **Pray** for continued unity and growth in their faith and for spiritual growth and protection for its members and the leaders.

- MON 10** – **Pray** for the weekly theology classes that started back July 2. Thank God for the 6 Spanish speaking and 9 English speaking participants. MTW and the Presbyterian Church in Belize are offering this online course through Third Mill. The most recent class was on Biblical Foundations. The third class begins Oct. 8th. **Pray** for the students as they grow in Bible knowledge to feel more at ease in sharing their faith as they lead. **Pray** that through the classes some men would feel called into the pastoral ministry Pray Proverbs 3:13 for them: “blessed are these who find wisdom, those who gain understanding.”
- TUES 11** – **Pray** for Pastor Ernest Betson and for his wife, Carolyn as they minister at St. Andrew’s and Unity churches in Belize City, Belize district and Bethany Presbyterian Church in Santa Elena, in the Cayo district. **Pray** for Carolyn as she will begin chemo this month. **Pray** for her healing and for her and Ernest to know and feel the love of God as they walk through this trial. **Pray** for the ministry of the Saint Andrews and Unity churches, the homeless feeding ministry, and Unity School. **Pray** for the officer candidates (Adrian, Mark, Owen, and Dennis) for the churches in Belize City. **Pray** for growth in spiritual maturity.
- WED 12** – **Pray** for the Presbyterian Medical Clinic staff as they serve the medical needs of patients, that they would be faithful to direct patients to Christ. The staff members are Pamela Murray, Dr. Einstein Boddien, Estela Uk, Ester Ruiz, Mariana Lopez, Patty Ku, Marcos Balaam, Hilario Nah, Arturo Ku, and Rosa Uh. **Pray** for the staff to remain healthy as they serve the community. **Pray** for Anita Chambers as she serves to coordinate from the US.
- THUR 13** – **Pray** for Pastor Alvaro Pott (wife Elsa) as they minister at Divino Redentor church in San Narciso, in the Corozal district. **Pray** their small group ministry would be a support and encouragement to church members. **Pray** for Pastor Alvaro as he serves as president of the executive committee of presbytery and general manager of the schools. **Pray** for Alvaro as he leads and for him to be an encouragement to others and a man of vision
- FRI 14** – **Pray** for the start of a church plant in the capital city of Belmopan. This church plant will begin with a Bible study one night a week in a home. **Pray** for those God wants to attend. We look to begin this month. **Pray** God will raise up an RUF (**Reformed University Fellowship**) pastor to join our team and work with university students in Belmopan and Belize City.
- SAT 15** – **Pray** for the ministry of Jacob's Farm in the Corozal district, a Presbyterian men's residential rehabilitation program, that their work would be far-reaching and effective, that the men's lives would be spiritually transformed, and that the men graduating from the program would be successfully enfolded in local churches, and communities. **Pray** for director Rodell Vallejos as he serves there.
- SUN 16** – **Pray** for the spiritual growth of all the youth as they will one day be the leaders of the churches. **Pray** for the youth to flee temptations and to run to God and continue to grow their faith. **Pray** they will be hungry for God’s word. **Pray** for consistent Sunday worship attendance across the denomination.
- MON 17** – **Pray** for missionary and pastor Ray Call and his wife Michele as he helps to pastor Faith Presbyterian Church in Orange Walk and Emmanuel church in San Pablo. Pray God would fill Ray with His Holy Spirit as he seeks to use his time strategically to help build up these churches. Pray for Michele as she leads Moms in Prayer meetings and a ministry wives group. Pray for wisdom as she balances family and ministry.

- TUES 18** – **Pray** for provision for the Presbyterian Medical clinic is currently in need of another nurse as one nurse is out on medical leave and not expected to come back to work the remainder of this year. **Pray** for nurses, and dentist's that are needed to come and serve alongside the clinic staff at the Presbyterian Medical Clinic for short term mission work, either for a week, or up to three months at a time.
- WED 19** – **Pray** for the 5-year strategic plan as revitalization is being implemented. **Pray** that God would grant wisdom in the effective in implementation of it. **Pray** it will result in growth in the churches, both numerically, and spiritually. **Praise** God for His love and continued faithfulness in the lives of all attending the Presbyterian churches.
- THUR 20** - **Pray** for all the church women's ministries. **Pray** the women grow in Bible knowledge, trust in God, growing their desire to share their faith with others, and serving those in their churches and communities.
- FRI 21**- **Pray** for the leaders of the country that God would lead them in the way they should go. **Pray** for the pastors' families, for strong marriages and for wisdom in parenting. **Pray** their family life would be characterized by love and grace and that the children of the pastors and church members would walk with Jesus. **Pray** the pastors would lead their churches and their families with humility and servants' hearts and with God's love for the ones they serve. **Pray** God's protection from the attacks of the evil one for each pastor and their families. (Pastors Alvaro Pott, Ernest Betson, Juan Patt, Leogardo Catzim. As well as Pastor Ray Call, and Elders John Stodghill, and Elder Isaias Botes). **Pray** for the power of the Holy Spirit as they share God's good news.
- SAT 22**– **Pray** for the MTW Belize team for continued unity, wisdom in decision making, a strong witness for Christ as well as protection from attacks from the evil one. **Pray** for the missionary children on the team, that God will meet their unique needs and that they would be a light for Jesus as they attend the local schools each day. **Pray** God will call more missionaries (2 ordained men, and their families, a pastoral intern, and a family practice/internal medicine physician or nurse practitioner) **Pray** God will call more Belizean men to serve as pastors for the Presbyterian Church in Belize.
- SUN 23** – **Pray** for strong covenant families in the PCB. **Pray** for the adults in our churches to be excited about their faith and to be a great example of trusting God as the younger generation watches and learns what is so special about a life with Christ. **Pray** families would have the spiritual, economic, and emotional resources to bring up their children in the nurture and admonition of the Lord, and to give God the thanks and glory for doing that. **Pray** for opportunities for church members to share their faith with others.
- MON 24** –**Pray** for Godly wisdom in leading this denomination. **Pray** for ruling elders: Solomon Noh, Ishmael Vallejos, Wilbert Vallejos, Hilario Nah, Isaias Botes, Desi Chan, Inocente Patt, John Sierra, Jose Gonzalez, Roman Chan, and Guillermo Laib, and John Stodghill. **Pray** the San Pablo church will be particularized. **Pray** God gives them wisdom in leading the churches in Belize. **Pray** that they will lead by example of living godly lives, shepherding, and building up those they lead and forgiving others as they have been forgiven.
- TUES 25** – **Pray** for Pastor Juan Patt (wife, Maria, and their two girls) as he ministers at Prince of Peace Presbyterian Church in Corozal Town and at Harvest Presbyterian Church in the village of Calcutta, both in the Corozal district. **Pray** God will continue to build the Prince of Peace and Harvest Presbyterian Churches. **Pray** for physical and spiritual health for Juan and Maria. **Pray** for the two potential male leaders who could serve in the leadership of the church. **Pray** the training for these men will be done soon. **Pray** for the soccer outreach ministry led by youth

leader Jeremy Zantingh at Prince of Peace church that it would reach the youth in the church and neighborhood.

WED 26 - Pray for Harvest Presbyterian Church (Calcutta Village mission church, near Corozal Town). **Pray** for Ismael Lopez, who is the lay leader living at the church and doing much of the ministry as well as working as the IT for the web page for the Presbyterian Churches in Belize, as well as IT for all the Presbyterian schools. Pray that he and his family would be firm in the faith and filled with the Holy Spirit. **Pray** for spiritual growth and maturity for the attendees of the mission, that they would be filled with knowledge and spiritual wisdom and would walk in a manner worthy of the Lord, fully pleasing to Him.

THUR 27 – Pray for restoration of interpersonal relationships throughout the churches. **Pray** God will grow the desire to treat others the way they want to be treated. **Pray** the church members would have wisdom from heaven that is first pure, then peace loving, considerate, submissive, full of mercy and good fruit, impartial and sincere. **Pray** for pastors & church leaders to flee and overcome any temptations and discouragement. **Pray** for their spiritual renewal. **Pray** that pastors, elders, deacons, SS teachers, clinic staff, and Presbyterian schoolteachers will be men and women of prayer and faithful witnesses for Christ.

FRI 28 – Pray for the Presbyterian Day School (PDS – the only truly private school in our network of schools) as they develop a long-term financial plan to support PDS teachers and students. Currently, they are needing financial assistance. MTW and the Belize team have set up an MTW account to assist the school with capital projects and shortfalls in teacher salaries. We are also soliciting child sponsors at \$25 USD per month (\$250 USD per student per year). **(Make donation to MTW Account #P-0364 and mark it as student tuition for PDS)**

SAT 29 - Pray for more pastors and elders to acquire the needed training to become ordained within this next year. **Pray** God would provide each church a pastor and each church would become particularized. **Pray** all the churches would become sustainable. There is a huge need for pastors, as there are 5 pastors and 16 churches/missions in the denomination.

SUN 30- Pray for the spiritual growth of church members. **Pray** for the joy of the Lord to be evident in their lives. **Pray** for John as the MTW Belize Team Leader as he works with the executive committee of presbytery to be more intentional in improving communication, and the direction this God given partnership is to go.

MON 31-Pray for united direction in leadership for all the pastors and elders across the denomination.
